Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing respondent no.2 i.e. the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur to issue to him an Arms License.

It is the categorical contention raised by counsel that an application complete in all respects had been submitted on 27.11.2017 before respondent no.2 for issuance of the Arms License but till date no final decision thereupon has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents and waives service. A complete copy of the petition already stands furnished to learned State counsel.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case an application for issuance of an Arms License submitted by the petitioner is still pending, the same would be processed in accordance with law and under the provisions of the Arms Act and rules framed thereunder and a final decision would be conveyed to the petitioner expeditiously and in any case within a period of two months from today.

In the light of such statement recorded of learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed.
