The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 257 dated 30.10.2017, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 500 grams of opium was recovered from him. The petitioner had been granted regular bail by the trial Court, but he could not appear before the Court on 05.03.2019 as he had noted wrong date. He undertakes that the petitioner shall appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by order dated 18.07.2019, had directed petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel states that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated 18.07.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the order dated 18.07.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
