By this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of interim bail till the report of the FSL is received.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he being otherwise licensed to sell the drugs that he was allegedly stated to have been apprehended with, the quantity of such drug (Tramadol tablets) in any case being 2450 tablets, with the total weight thereof being 245 grams, whereas commercial quantity is above 250 grams.

Learned State counsel submits that even if the petitioner is licensed to sell the aforesaid drugs, he did not produce any bill with regard to purchase of the said drugs.

Since the FSL report is still to be received as regards the quantity of the drugs, without making any comment on the contention raised in the petition, since the petitioner is behind bars for the last 3 months and 5

days, as per the custody certificate filed in court today by the learned State counsel, this petition is allowed.

The petitioner is ordered to be admitted to interim bail upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur, till the FSL report is received.
