**Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)**

File again taken up on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, since he states that the parole of the petitioner is going to expire on 26.7.2019. As such, the previous order passed in the earlier hours of the day is recalled.

Heard.

Petitioner was granted six weeks agricultural parole by the Commissioner, Gurguram Division, Gurugram on 12.6.2019. Now, he seeks extension of the parole on the medical grounds stating that there is stone in his gall bladder, which is required to be removed and for which he has been advised operation. Jail authorities, vide order dated 12.7.2019 (Annexure P-1) declined the same on the ground that there is no provision for extension of the parole and that the treatment can be given in the hospital. Petitioner has annexed outdoor patient health ticket (Annexure P-

3), which shows that he was having pain in the abdomen for the last three years. He has been advised surgery cholecystectomy.

I am of the view that the petitioner has stone in the gall bladder, for which, he was complaining of pain for three years. He has already availed six weeks parole. Laparoscopy is done to remove the stone in the gall balader, which can be got done by the jail authorities. If some other operation is required same can also be got done by the jail authorities by removing him to hospital.

It being so, there is no ground to extend the parole. However, it shall always be open to the petitioner to apply for medical parole, if his condition after operation so warrants. However, it shall be for the jail authorities to consider and decide the same on merits.

Resultantly, the present petition stands disposed of.
