AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondent No.1, with reference to Clause 13 of the brochure as found mentioned at page 74 of the paper book, contends that the petitioner has a remedy to approach the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab-respondent No.2 for arbitration of the matter.

If that be so, the petitioner may avail of his remedy of arbitration by filing an appropriate application/representation/petition to the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab-respondent No.2 within a period of 15 days from today. On submission of such an application/representation/petition, respondent No.2 himself or his nominee shall make

an endeavour to decide the arbitration proceedings at an early date, preferably within a period of nine months from the date of reference.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above observations/directions.

Since the main writ petition stands disposed of, no orders are required to be passed on C.M. Nos.12178-CWP-2015 and 1589-CWP-2019.
