The petitioners seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the pay scale and other emoluments prescribed for the post upon which they were called upon to perform the duties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that payment has been made to petitioner Nos. 1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10 to 15, 18, 19, 21 to 25, 27, 28, 31, 33 and 35 whereas, payment bill of petitioner No.26 has been sent to the treasury. The payment with regard to remaining petitioners will be made shortly.

In view of above, the State is directed to make the payment to the remaining petitioners within eight weeks from today. In case the payment is not released within the stipulated period, the same shall carry interest @ 8% per annum from the date, the claim of the

petitioners was admitted i.e. 31.08.2016.
