1. Prayer is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 19.06.2018 (Annexure P/13), passed by respondent No.3, whereby the petitioner was directed to pay ₹1,60,000/- to respondent No.4 within 48 hours of receipt of copy of order.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.4 had also filed a civil suit against the petitioner in February, 2019 and on payment of ₹7,50,000/- on account of salary and gratuity, respondent No.4 withdrew the civil suit on 01.03.2019. Photocopy of the statement of respondent No.4 made before the learned Civil Court as well as the order passed on the same dated 01.03.2019 is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel states that in the circumstances no further orders are called for in the writ petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
