FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose off first regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. moved in FIR No. 53 dated 05.05.2019 under Sections 363, 366-A, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC Police Station Dabba Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The precise allegations have been levelled by complainant-Baljinder Singh father of the girl aged around 16 years. It is alleged that on 05.05.2019 around 10.00 a.m., in the morning, his

daughter left the house and, subsequently, it was revealed that she has eloped with son of the petitioner leading to the registration of the case.

Ms. Alisha Soni, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind the bars for almost 02 months and no specific role is attributed to her as the girl has eloped on her own.

Mr. H.S. Grewal, Addl. A.G., Punjab assisted by ASI Balwinder Singh though does not disagrees with the facts but has opposed the grant of the bail on the grounds of heinousness of the crime.

Going through the submissions and in the light of what has been brought to the notice of the Court as no specific role could be pointed out by the learned State counsel and considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for almost 02 months, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case for grant of bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, it is made clear that anything observed herein shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case.
