ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 735, dated 22.09.2018, under Sections 394, 341, 324, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that a mobile phone was snatched from the complainant. He also contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused who was arrested in another case. He is 21 years of age and in custody for over 08 months since his arrest on 11.02.2019.

Learned State counsel states that the investigation has been completed and the challan has been presented and 03 out of 16 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 08 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
