This is fifth attempt on behalf of the petitioner to seek regular bail in case FIR No.108 dated 8.4.2016 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

In CRM-M No.4326 of 2019, petitioner was relegated to approach the Court of Sessions at the first instance in view of changed circumstances (if any) according to the petitioner. Petitioner was required to submit details of cases where he has been exonerated, granted bail or discharged by the Court. Court of Sessions was directed to decide the petition in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

The trial Court has recorded the fact on the basis of custody certificate sent by Superintendent of Jail that nine cases are still pending against the petitioner. In one of the case, he has been convicted. Petitioner is alleged to be a gangster. Initially he was involved in 43 cases. According to the petitioner the tally has been brought down to nine.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaskaran Singh, states that out of total 15 prosecution witnesses, six of the witnesses have already been examined, three have been given up and remaining six of the witnesses have been bound down for the adjourned date i.e. 20.8.2019. In all probability, the remaining witnesses would be examined either on the adjourned date or soon thereafter.

In view of above, this petition is dismissed. However the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
