This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 144 dated 23.04.2019, registered under Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 of the Immoral Traffic Act, 1956 at Police Station DLF Phase-I, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits as per the allegations in the FIR, the police, on receiving an information that under the disguise of Avon Spa, a brothel is being run by some ladies, the police conducted a raid and arrested Annadas @ Pooja and Gaichamei Rongmei @ Jaini and recovered a sum of Rs. 2,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though the petitioner is the owner of the premises, however, he has been working as the Manager Finance in a private company for the last nine years and has no

history of involvement in any such case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the aforesaid co-accused, who were arrested at the spot, have already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 28.05.2019 passed in **CRM-M-23701-2019**.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bahi Ram and on the basis of the custody certificate, has not disputed the factual position that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and submitted that challan has been presented and the case is now fixed for framing of charges.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that two of the co-accused have already been granted concession of regular bail by this Court as noticed above; the petitioner is in judicial custody since 02.07.2019; he is not involved in any other case; challan stands presented and also in view of the fact that the trial is likely to take some time, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
