Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P5), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga, whereby petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* raised different grounds to make out a case that petitioner was unable to appear before the learned trial Court on the date fixed.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent. A complete copy of paper-book be provided to him during the course of the day.

Be that as it may, present petition stands disposed of with the

directions that in case petitioners surrenders before the learned trial Court

within a period of one week from today and moves an application for admitting her to bail, the learned trial Judge shall decide the same within a period of one week thereafter. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to take all the pleas, as raised in the present petition, before the learned trial Judge.
