Petitioner Gurpreet Banga @ Ashok @ Shoka has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.62 dated 16.05.2019, registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Jalandhar Commissionerate, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

I have perused the suicide note in the police file. As per the suicide note, the accused including the present petitioner caused injuries to deceased Manjit Lal in the month of February and he remained in the Civil hospital for 25 days. Some fractures have also found on his person and his

grievance in the suicide note, prima facie is that the police has not taken any action against the accused and he is suffering injuries pain.

The petitioner has been in custody since 22.05.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
