The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to consider their claim for regularization w.e.f the date when their juniors were regularized. The petition was allowed on 07.03.2019 and respondents were directed to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularization, on parity with their juniors. The speaking order was to be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents fairly submits that *Intra Court Appeal* preferred by the respondents was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file review petition. She further submits that the review petition was dismissed

on 03.10.2019 and the respondents are in process of filing SLP.

She submits that the needful for the compliance of the directions of this Court would be done within three months from today, subject to the outcome of pending litigation and in case the order of learned Single Judge is neither stayed nor modified.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of.
