The application is allowed, as prayed. Reply filed on behalf of
respondent no.2 is taken on record.

Criminal Misc. No.M-30419 of 2019:

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the
petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 28.01.2019 under Sections 498-A/406
IPC registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 19.07.2019, while directing the petitioner to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer within seven days, interim bail was granted to him and he was directed to deposit Rs.25,000/- by way of bank draft in the name of respondent no.2 before the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Patiala towards litigation expenses. However, no such amount has been deposited by the petitioner.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
