This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to decide the representation (Annexure P-16) and take action against respondent Nos. 5 to 13 for raising a colony illegally.

On oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, Director, Local Bodies, Punjab is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No. 14 in the memo of parties.

Registry is directed to make the necessary amendment in the memo of parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to newly added respondent No.14 – Director, Local Bodies, Punjab to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-16) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Ms.Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to newly added respondent No.14 – Director, Local Bodies, Punjab to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-16) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
