On 22.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted concession of regular bail vide order dated 14.05.2019 and now the police is seeking to arrest the petitioner on addition of certain offence without seeking permission of the Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Manish Verma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 06.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds

and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 22.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
