ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has challenged the order of the appellate Court dated 20.05.2019 whereby he has been directed to deposit 20% of the compensation awarded by the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would confine his prayer in this petition for extension of time to deposit 20% of the amount of compensation as directed by the appellate Court. He further states that the financial condition of the petitioner is not sound and it is difficult for him to deposit the amount which has to be raised from various sources. He, thus, requires more time to deposit the same.

In view of the limited nature of prayer of the petitioner, I do not deem it necessary to issue notice to the respondent. The petitioner was directed to deposit 20% of the amount by the trial Court on 20.05.2019. It would be in the interest of justice, if the time is extended by a period of one month.

The petitioner shall deposit 20% of the compensation amount within a period of one month from now.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
