Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 12.06.2019, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide which, the application filed by the petitioner for release of a vehicle make Tata 407, bearing registration No. PB-11-J-3889, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the registered owner of the said vehicle is one Pawandeep Singh Gill and the petitioner has purchased the same on the basis of an affidavit and on that account, the trial Court has declined to release the said vehicle in favour of the petitioner as he is not the registered owner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, submits that the respondent-State has no objection in case the said vehicle is released in favour of the registered owner.

In reply, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move an appropriate application on behalf of the registered owner Pawandeep Singh

Gill for release of the said vehicle on *Superdari*.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application through said Pawandeep Singh Gill for release of the vehicle and in case any such application is filed, the trial Court shall release the vehicle in favour of the registered owner, subject to furnishing requisite bail/surety bonds.
