Grievance of the petitioners is that they are not being accorded the benefit of pay scales of ₹10300-34800 along with grade pay of ₹4200/- as admissible to them in accordance with law and the same is in violation of basic principles of equal pay for equal work.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners relies on a judgment dated 26.10.2018 rendered by this Court in CWP-2063-2015 (Annexure P-5) and contends that the case of the petitioners is identical and squarely covered by the same.

3. In the premise, the petitioners also submitted representations dated 08.10.2014 and 10.12.2014 (Annexure P4) but the same were not adverted by the respondents and hence the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On an advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Sr. Advocate with Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents, as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required in the present case.
7. In the premise, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 08.10.2014 and 10.12.2014 (Annexure P4) of the petitioners and pass a speaking order in terms of judgment dated 26.10.2018 rendered by this Court in CWP-2063-2015 (Annexure P-5) and also by keeping in view the averments and contentions stated in this petition, in accordance with law.
8. Let needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
9. Disposed of in above terms.
