Pursuant to the order of this Court dated July 19, 2019, Mr. APS Gill, learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and the car which he is stated to have been driving as per the case of the police, already stands recovered, with the other cars also stated to be containing liquor in them, also recovered.

That being so, this petition is allowed, with the order dated July 19, 2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

It is to be observed that in the said order it has erroneously been recorded by this Court that the drivers of all the cars had fled away, whereas actually, Gursewak Singh and Gurtej Singh, are shown to have been apprehended at the spot, with the other persons who are stated to be also occupants of the car, having allegedly fled away.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
