Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to consider the application of the petitioner for the post of 'Constable' in District Police Cadre and Armed Police Cadre (Ferozepur). Another similarly situated candidate who also secured 27 marks and like petitioner belongs to 'Scheduled Caste' Category has been considered and given the benefit of appointment.

2. In the premise, petitioner submitted his representations dated 02.01.2019 and 12.03.2019 (Annexures P-8 and P-9 respectively) but the same were not adverted by the respondents and hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued, as there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.
5. Let the needful be done within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
