On 29.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.154, dated 27.06.2019, registered under Section 22-B of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the petitioner has been nominated on the statement of co-accused and there is no recovery from the petitioner. He has further pointed out that Harjinder Singh had disclosed to the police that he along with his friend Krishan Singh had purchased the “tramadol” tablets from hotel situated near Bus Stand, Patiala, which was part of the reply filed before the learned Special Court to the application for bail. However, thereafter a supplementary disclosure statement was recorded and the petitioner has been falsely nominated.

Notice of motion for 21.10.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, petitioner is directed to join investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, the order dated 29.08.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
