The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 149 dated 07.08.2018, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 22.07.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Amarjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 22.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
