Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.9 dated 27.04.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Vide order dated 19.07.2019 this Court while considering the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready to take his wife from the court premises itself and the allegation of demand of car is incorrect as the petitioner is already maintaining a car, had referred the matter to the Mediation and Cociliation Centre of this Court. Accordingly, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediator on 07.08.2019.

the Mediator and accordingly, settlement/agreement dated 06.09.2019 has been reduced into the writing.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the settlement/agreement dated 06.09.2019 has been reduced into writing, which has been duly signed by respondent No.2, the present petition stands disposed of.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days' notice be given to him.

The settlement/agreement dated 06.09.2019 be made part of the record. The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/agreement in letter and spirit.
