The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.42 dated 08.06.2019, under Sections 452, 326, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Qadian, District Batala.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners had contended that the allegations against the petitioners, who are ladies, are that they had caused 'dang' blows on the non-vital part of the body of the complainant and his wife. The injury for which Section 326 IPC has been invoked is attributed to other co-accused.

This Court, by the order dated 22.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the petitioners having joined investigation and not being required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 22.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
