B.S. Walia, J. (Oral),

1. Learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Sandeep Kumar Rana, Advocate, states that in view of the concluding paragraph of order, Annexure R-1 dated 16.09.2019 passed by the Director Elementary Education Haryana, Panchkula, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the writ petition any further, consequently, the writ petition be disposed of as having become infructuous but the respondents be directed to make payment of monetary benefits to the petitioner as per entitlement in terms of order Annexure R-1 within a stipulated period of time.

2. Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, states that he has no objection to the aforementioned innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

3. In the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous. However, monetary benefits as per entitlement in terms of order Annexure R-1 dated 16.9.2019 be disbursed to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from today, failing which the same shall be paid along

with interest @ 7.5% per annum with effect from the date of entitlement till date of payment.

4. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
