This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the search of detenue-Shabnam.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Nuh, District Nuh Mewat (Haryana) was directed to visit the house of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and make enquiry as to whether detenue Shabnam is residing there with her own consent or has been confined illegally by respondent Nos.4 to 6. If respondent No.3-SHO finds that the detenue has been kept forcibly against her wishes, then she be produced immediately before this Court. Otherwise, a detailed report be submitted.

Status report has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State. Same has been taken on record.

Alleged detenue Shabnam is present in the Court. She has come from her father's house and states that she wants to go to her in-laws

house, where her husband and three children are residing.

Alleged detainee-Shabnam is free to go to her in-laws house.

In view of statement made by the detainee, no further action is required in this matter.

Disposed of accordingly.

SI Narender Kumar, who is present in the Court, is directed to leave the detainee to her house under full protection and if anything happens, then he will be responsible for that.
