The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 5.3.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 5743 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without commenting on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to decide the present petition with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible. Ordered accordingly.”

As per order dated 5.3.2019, the respondents had to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible.

As per the averments made in the petition, copy of the order

passed by this Court was sent to the respondents which was acknowledged on 22.4.2019.

Though there was no time bound direction by this court but the observation of this Court was that the representation shall be decided as expeditiously as possible.

No case is made out for initiating contempt proceedings. However, the respondents would consider the seriousness of the matter with regard to the observations made by this Court. The respondents shall ensure compliance of the order as expeditiously as possible.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
