Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondent to release the payment of ₹10,00,606.33 as found due to the petitioner by learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Officer, Hisar, vide order dated 30.04.2008 (Annexure P-1).

At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent states that on re-appraisal of the record, the respondent has taken a decision to make payment towards entire claim laid by the petitioner to the extent of ₹10,00,606.33. The necessary statement shall be made in the Company Application No.130 of 2018 in Company Petition No.198 of 1999, which is coming up for hearing on 29.10.2019.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, in case, the statement made at Bar is not honoured by

the respondent, the petitioner shall have the liberty to revive the instant petition, within a period of three months from the date of adjudication of the matter by the Company Court.
