The present revision petition has been filed against the order dated 9.5.2019 directing the petitioners to comply with the order of the High Court dated 18.12.2018 as security already stands furnished by the decree holder as well as against the order dated 26.2.2019, vide which, the security was furnished by the respondent, was accepted.

While praying for setting aside both the orders, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the security furnished is not in consonance with the amount to be released by the petitioners. The security is not sufficient.

However, the said argument has no merit. Security is to be to the satisfaction of the Executing Court. Moreover, as per the order dated 26.2.2019, it is evident that the copies of the sale deeds submitted as security have been returned after making endorsement on the same that the property shall not be sold without permission of the Court. The present revision petition is, therefore, totally misconceived.

Dismissed accordingly.
