Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 29.06.2019 under Sections 61/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 22.07.2019: -

“....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police party, on receiving an information that the petitioner is bringing liquor on cheaper rates from Chandigarh and is selling the same at higher rates, conducted a raid at his house and in absence of the petitioner, recovered 06 bottles of whisky, which is meant for sale in Chandigarh only....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasmer Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
