Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for setting aside the order dated 27.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar and the order dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar.

Admittedly, the claimants-respondents are wife and two minor children. In the petition filed by the respondents under Section 125 Cr.P.C., Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar, vide order dated 27.09.2017 has granted interim maintenance @ Rs.7,000/- to the wife and Rs.5,000/- each to the daughters. In this manner, total ad interim maintenance was fixed @ Rs.17,000/- per month in favour of the respondent payable by the petitioner. The said order was challenged by way of revision petition, which was dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, vide order dated 19.03.2019. The main petition is still pending.

The argument of the learned counsel that the petitioner is ready

to settle the dispute with the respondent-wife can safely be made before the trial Court, where the maintenance petition is pending. No ground for interference is thus made out.

Dismissed.
