On 19.07.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner being Ex-Sarpanch and due to rival faction in the village, petitioner is sought to be falsely implicated. He further submits that although the petitioner is alleged to have fired with the pistol in air, however, no empty has been recovered to prove that it is the petitioner who fired the bullet from the pistol.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to learned counsel for the State.

Mr. Arshdeep Singh Brar, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of complainant/first informant and has informed the Court that another FIR against the petitioner has been registered on 22.06.2018 alleging land grabbing.

Adjourned to 13.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner

shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall continue to cooperate with the trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.

The petition stands disposed of.
