Grievance of the petitioners is that despite applicability of Punjab Civil Service Rules Volume-I on the employees (petitioners) of respondent No.3-College, they have not been extended the benefit of different kinds of leave viz. Earned leave, half pay leave, commuted leave, leave not due, extraordinary leave etc. per the Rules, *ibid*.

2. The petitioners submitted a representation dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the present writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On an advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Sr. Advocate with Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents, as no further proceedings and/or

pleadings are required in the present case.

7. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the averments and contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

8. Let needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
