Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the the stay was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 31.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) subject to payment of rent of six months as per judgemnt dated 24.04.2019 and the arrears of rent was paid by the petitioner as per receipt (Annexure P-4). However on 09.07.2019 fresh vakalatnama was produced by learned counsel appearing for the appellant and the case was adjourned for 18.07.2019 and the stay was not extended. Since the petitioner had deposited the entire rent as is evident from the receipt (Annexure P-4) and in this backdrop, stay granted to him vide order dated 31.05.2019 should have been extended till the final decision of the appeal.

Hence, petition is allowed and the orders dated 08.07.2019 and 09.07.2019 are being set aside and the stay order granted vide order dated 31.05.2019 shall continue till the final decision of the appeal subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit rent till 10th of every month after

June, 2019 and the petitioner will deposit Rs.10,000/- as costs with the District Legal Services Authority, Gurugram.
