Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh states that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is now listed for examination of the defence witnesses on 11.12.2019. He further states that every effort shall be made to expedite the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has furnished copies of the orders passed by the trial Court, which indicates that from 17.08.2019, the matter has been adjourned on 09 occasions and no headway has been made in the trial.

He, however, contends that he wants to withdraw this petition and the trial Court be directed to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.
