AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 19.12.2018 passed by this Court in bunch of writ petitions, main being CWP No.18499 of 2018.

Learned State counsel has produced order dated 23.10.2019 passed by Mr. Sukhjeet Pal Singh, PCS, Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, same is taken on record. Copy of order is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Dharampal, Assistant, O/o the Director Public Instructions (S.E.), Punjab, states that petitioners at Sr. No.1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13,

14, 15, 16, 17, 19 and 20 (in the writ petition) have been given promotions. As regards petitioners No.5, 7 and 18, she tenders unconditional apology for the delay and submits that delay occurred as the seniority was to be re-cast considering the previous service in other departments. She states that needful will be done within three months from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, it is made clear that in case needful is not done or statement made today is found factually incorrect, petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
