Separate replies filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and respondents No.4 to 6 in the Court today are taken on record.

In the present writ petition, the grievance raised by the petitioner is that the retiral benefits in respect of the service rendered by her late husband have not been released so far.

Counsel for the respondents states that all the benefits, for which the petitioner was entitled have already been released and the details of the payments released have been mentioned in paragraph 2 of the written statement filed on behalf of respondents No 4 to 6.

Counsel for the petitioner states that though, he has no instructions from the petitioner with regard to the payment so made by the respondents but

once the counsel for the respondents has made statement before this Court giving details of the payments released to the petitioner, he will not dispute the same. He prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court, in case the benefits are not released to the petitioner so far and further a liberty be given to the petitioner to approach the respondents raising her claim for grant of interest, if any, keeping in view the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in A.S. Randhawa vs. State of Punjab 1997 (3) S.C.T. 468.

Counsel for the respondents very fairly states that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming interest, the same will be considered by the respondents in accordance with law by passing an appropriate order within a period of three months from the date of filing of the representation.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
