On 04.04.2019, writ petition was adjourned as there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner. On 19.08.2019, following order was passed :-

*“Counsel for the respondents-State states that the prayer of the petitioner in the present writ petition is for counting his previous service which he had rendered in Haryana State Minor Irrigation and Tubewell Corporation Limited as a qualifying service for pensionary benefits and this question has already been considered by the Division Bench of this Court in **LPA No. 1105 of 2017** titled as **'The State of Haryana and others Vs. Nathu Singh, on 29.05.2018** wherein, it has been held that previous service rendered by an employee cannot be counted for any purpose.*

As there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 26.08.2019.

To be taken up after urgent cases.”

Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Keeping in view the facts mentioned above, it can be safely presumed that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present writ petition any further.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
