The present writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* to comply with the RBI Circular dated 28.09.2006 (Annexure P-3) on the ground that the truck of the petitioner was forcibly taken at the instance of respondent No.6-Bank in default of payment of the loan amount.

2.) Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent Nos.5 and 6 state that the truck in question has already been released by the financier and restored to the custody of the petitioner. Even otherwise, the order sheet of the case reflects that despite ample opportunity, the petitioner has not been pursuing his cause. In view thereof, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court for mitigation of his grievance, if any.
