After going through the writ petition, we have found that the averments are vague inasmuch as in Para 9, it has been mentioned that the respondents No. 5 and 6 have caused huge loss to the Panchayat by cutting the plots and allotted to the people without any prior approval from the authorities and without passing any resolution. The petitioner is not aware of the names of the persons to whom said plots are given though he is the resident of the same village.

Faced with these observations, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to file it again with better particulars especially mentioning the names of the persons to whom the plots have been allotted so that appropriate direction may be issued.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.
