On 22.07.2019, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that initially FIR was registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, IPC, however, by way of special report, the offence under Section 452 of the Indian Penal Code was added. He further submits that the petitioners have also suffered injuries.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 03.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh,
has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated
and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 22.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
