HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the pensionary benefits of the petitioner has wrongly been calculated by the respondent-society especially the leave encashment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the benefit of leave encashment has been calculated by the respondent-society keeping in view the pay which the petitioner was getting in the year 2002 whereas the same was required to be calculated on the salary on the date when the petitioner superannuated.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to the respondents to re-calculate the leave encashment of the petitioner and grant the petitioner correct amount of leave encashment which is entitled under the rules.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation to the respondents-Hafed, which is the apex body of the society under which the petitioner was working, on 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents

and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-9), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 10.06.2019 (Annexure P-9), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
