In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been released his salary for the strike period, i.e. from 16.10.2018 to 02.11.2018. Counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner has duly worked for strike period and to support the said contention, counsel relies on attendance register for the said period attached as Annexure P-3.

Counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner has already retired on 31.03.2019 and the petitioner has also not been released the salary from January, 2019 onwards as well. Counsel prays that the direction be issued to the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner for the strike period as well as salary for the months of January, 2019 to March, 2019.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has

been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served upon the respondents with a legal notice dated 12.02.2019 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 12.02.2019 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
