Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned transfer order dated 12.07.2019 (Annexure P-10) vide which he was transferred from Government College Hoshiarpur to Government College Kala Afgana (Gurdaspur).

2. Having heard the learned counsel, I am not inclined to interfere under extra-ordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court, as transfers are matters of administrative exigencies.

3. Confronted with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to take a final decision by treating the present petition as a representation.

4. Submission made by learned counsel is found to be just

and reasonable.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with an observation that the respondents may sympathetically look into the averments of the petitioner per the instant petition by treating it as a representation and take a final decision in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
