This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ quashing the impugned memo dated 23.11.2011 (Annexure P-7) wherein it has been decided that “the services rendered in Classical & Vernacular scale prior to 01.01.1986 shall not be counted for proficiency step up”.

As per the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, it has been clarified that in view of the judgment passed in ***CWP No.16095 of 2012*** titled as '***Baldev Singh and others Versus State of Punjab***', on 16.05.2016, it has been decided that Classical and Vernacular scale will be counted for the purpose of granting the proficiency step up. Therefore, the grievance of the petitioners stands fully redressed. However, learned counsel for the petitioner states that necessary payment has not been made to the petitioners.

In the circumstances, considering the admitted position, the respondents are directed to make the necessary payment expeditiously.

Disposed of, accordingly.
