GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (ORAL)

Today, at the time of hearing of the present case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main writ petition was filed with the prayer to issue a writ of certiorari to quash the award dated 06.12.2016 (Annexure P-1).

During the pendency of the present petition, the parties have arrived at an out of Court settlement. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement to withdraw the present writ petition. He further submits that respondent No.2 is Sh. Ram Dev, son of Girdhari Lal (though it is stated at the bar that by way of typographical mistake it was wrongly typed as Son of Sardari Lal in the memo of parties). He contends that respondent No.2 is present in Court and both parties make a joint statement to seek permission to withdraw the writ petition.

Said Ram Dev, who is present in Court has given a copy of his Aadhar Card, which is taken on record as mark A. He also handed over his affidavit mentioning therein that a compromise has been effected, with the

consent of both the parties and without any pressure or force.

Counsel for the petitioner further requests that the legal issue may kindly be kept open as the writ petition has been withdrawn in view of the out of Court settlement.

In these circumstances, prayer is accepted and the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It also needs to be directed that the amount of Rs.15,000/- deposited by the petitioner with the Registry of this Court in pursuance of order dated 23.02.2017 be returned/deposited in the account of respondent No.2, who has given details of his account, a photocopy of which is taken on record as mark B.

Ordered accordingly.
