Grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that in pursuance to the advertisement dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-3), he was appointed vide letter dated 27.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) as Assistant Professor in Health & Physical Education on temporary basis under self financing scheme. However, vide advertisement (Annexure P-9) fresh applications were invited for filling up various posts and respondent No.5 was appointed. In such circumstances, the petitioner approached this Court for issuance of appropriate direction keeping in view his appointment and for violation of the directions contained in the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Hargurpratap Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others,

2007(13) SCC 292.

Noticing the above contention, this Court issued notice of motion. Mr. Arora, learned counsel appearing for private respondents No.3 and 4 submits that in the fresh advertisement, the petitioner's claim was considered as per the proceedings of the Selection Committee and he was not found to be in the merit list. Even otherwise, respondent No.5 has been appointed, however, for the academic session 2018-19, there is no workload.

Keeping in view the aforementioned contention that the petitioner was a contractual employee and there is no workload with the respondents, the decision taken was totally only on the basis of self-financing scheme. The petitioner has also not been able to fall in the merit list in the second selection process.

Hence, I do not find any reason to exercise powers of judicial review.

The writ petition is dismissed.
