The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.25 dated 25.03.2019, under Sections 309, 452, 323, 294 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had thrown a brickbat on the complainant and the injury therefrom has been found to be simple in nature. The petitioner is in custody for over five months and the incident took place due to sudden quarrel between the neighbours.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, states that none of the 14 prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature, the petitioner is not involved in any other case, he is in custody for over five months and trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the

concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
